# In-car Observation & Behind-the-wheel Instruction Log

Complete the 7 hours of in-car observation and 7 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction with the Parent Taught instructor registered with the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR). The curriculum for this log can be found in the Driving Manager section of your Aceable course. Per state regulations, students may complete no more than 4 hours of in-car training per day, with no more than 2 of those hours being behind-the-wheel instruction. You may bring this log with you to the DPS when applying for your provisional license, but that is not mandatory.

<b>Driver Preparation, Starting, Operation, &amp; Post-Drive Tasks</b>	In-Car Observation	1/1/20XX	10 AM	30 minutes	<b>HOW TO FILL OUT THIS LOG</b>  Students may complete no more than 4 hours of in-car training per day, with no more than 2 of those hours being behind-the-wheel instruction.  Keep in mind that students are also only allowed a maximum of 6 hours of total instruction in a single day. This can be, however, a combination of allowable hours in classroom instruction, in-car observation, and behind-the-wheel instruction.  In our example, you can see that on 1/1/20XX, the student logged a total of 3 hours of in-car observation and behind-the-wheel instruction. This means that they should not log more than 2 hours of classroom time in their Classroom Instruction Log for the same day.
